- Completion of community college vocational maintenance course preferred.
- Must possess five years of continuous maintenance experience in an industrial sewing setting.
- Must possess general knowledge of maintenance equipment, both manual and powered.
- Must possess general knowledge of machine shop equipment including lathes, power saws, welders, drills, and other related equipment.
- Knowledge of the following types of sewing equipment desired:
 - Lockstitch sewing machines (single and double needle)
 - Chain stitch machines (Single thread and multi-thread, single needle and multi-needle)
 - Over Lock (serger and safety stitch)
 - Button and Buttonhole machine
 - Steam Irons and Steam System
 - Needle positioner, thread trimmers, electronic and pneumatic devices and equipment.
- Special consideration will be given to individuals with direct experience in the repair and maintenance of programmable equipment and robotics.
- Must possess experience in the repair and material handling, forklifts and routine manufacturing equipment.
- Must be able to follow written and verbal instructions.
