Executive Summary

The combined data bases of Alabama Institute of Deaf and Blind (AIDB) indicate that AIDB impacted the lives of 24,932 individuals with hearing and vision loss and their families during the fiscal year October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2017. This number includes students and clients who receive ongoing services as well as one-time services during the course of the year. An attempt is made to consider duplication of services provided through different units.

The report includes data tracked through campus and outreach programs including Alabama School for the Deaf, Alabama School for the Blind, Helen Keller School, E. H. Gentry Technical Facility, Regional Centers, Health and Clinical Services, Alabama Industries for the Blind, Outreach, Instructional Resource Center for the Blind (AIRCB) and Initiative for Children and Youth who are DeafBlind.

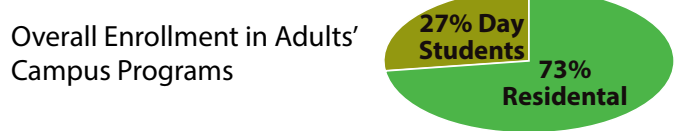
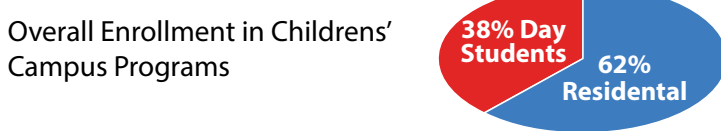
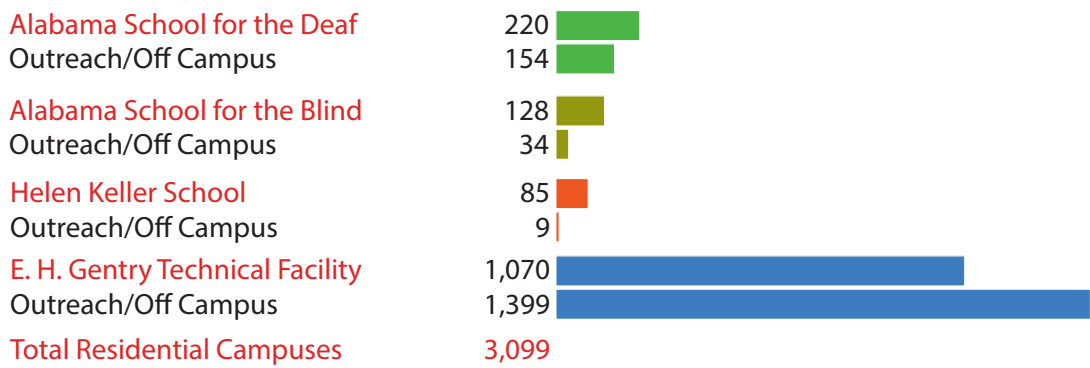

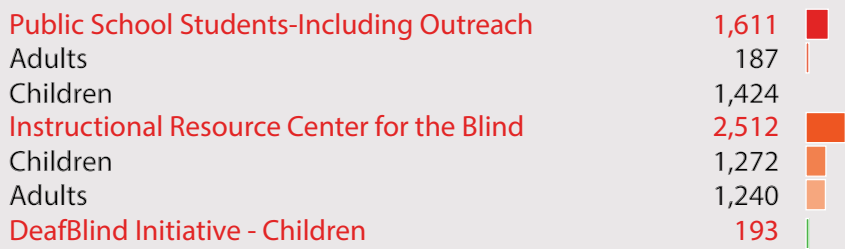

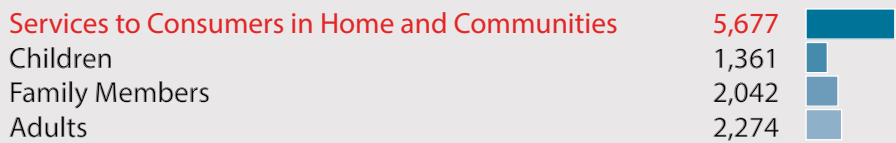

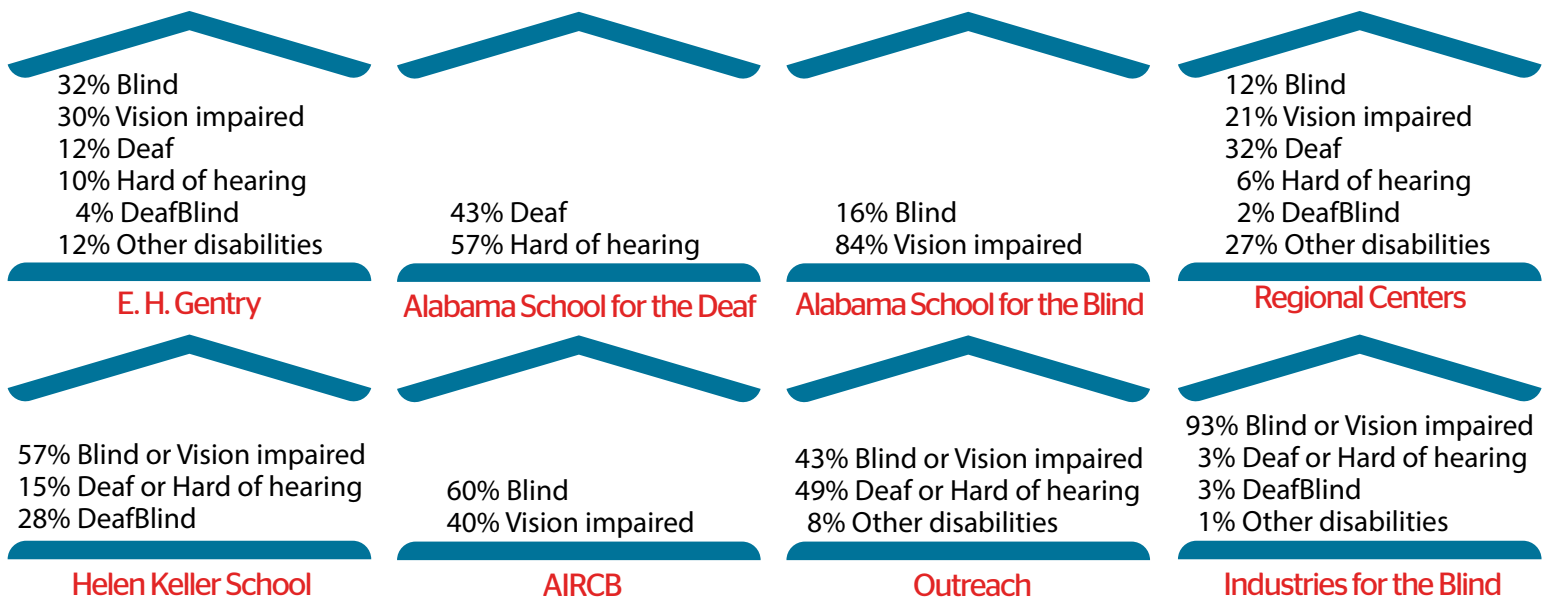

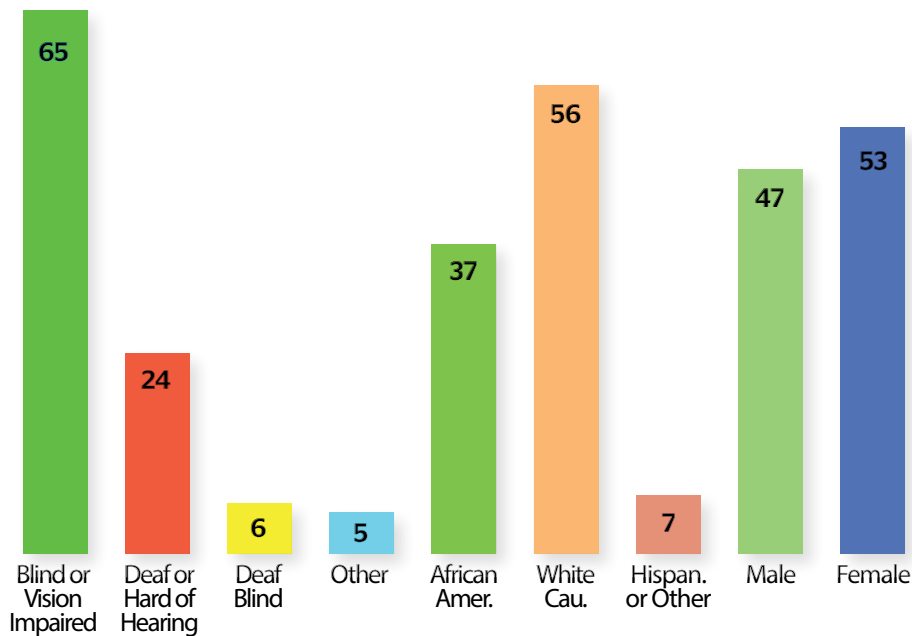
AIDB Neighborhood AIDB Populations by Unit



AIDB Student and Consumer Demographics*

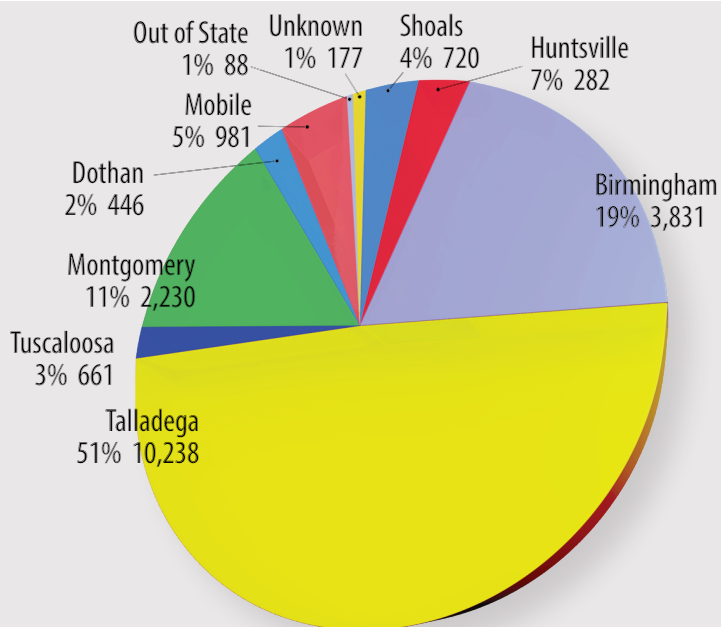

*By percentage (%) of total population served



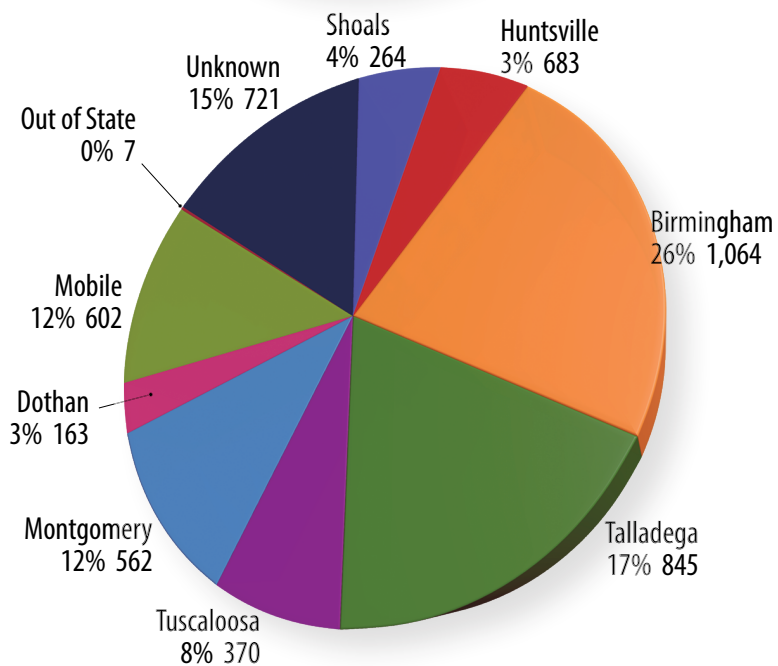
Total Adults Served by Region

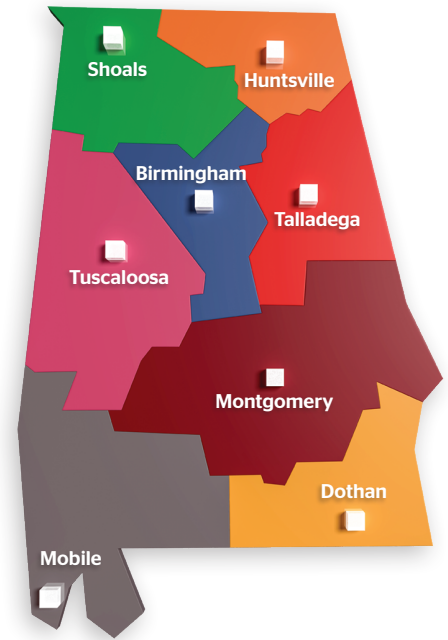
